NMHCS effectively manages and integrates prescription benefits programs with technology. NMHCS is a pharmaceutical prescription card solution that originally required 2 separate hardware platforms – NT and DataGeneral. It has migrated from the old legacy environment to the new state of the art application, PHI. PHI is an OLTP & DSS environment using Oracle 8.15 as the database. PHI is currently installed on the N-Class running HP-UX 11.0 utilizing MC ServiceGuard for High Availability.

Because of the high volume of transactions and the growing business, Sandata has selected the XP-256 for all storage requirements. The XP-256 has approximately 2 TB of available storage to accommodate for the multiple applications that will be connected to the storage array. Mike Koslosky stated, "the XP-256 allows the ability to quickly expand storage and connectivity with minimal to no disruption of service to my end users." The N-Class server was selected because, "it is the only cost-effective solution to support the 100,000 plus calls per day that are managed by Santrax," confirmed Mike Koslosky.
